The Novena to the Holy Spirit

The novena in honour of the Holy Spirit is the oldest of all novenas since it was first made at the directions of Our Lord Himself when He sent His Apostles back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Ghost on the first Pentecost. It is still the only novena prescribed by the Church. Addressed to the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, it is a powerful plea for the light and strength and love so sorely needed by every Christian.

The novena prayer is traditionally prayed from the Friday after Ascension Thursday until the Saturday before Pentecost.



Come, O Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Thy faithful, and enkindle in them the fire of Thy love.

Send forth Thy Spirit and they shall be created.
And Thou shalt renew the face of the earth
Let us pray --- Oh God Who didst instruct the hearts of the
faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant us in the same
Spirit to be truly wise and to ever rejoice in His consolations,
through Jesus Christ Our Lord. Amen.

Rogation Sunday 4th/5th May

Rogation is an ancient church festival to seek blessing for a community and its sustenance. The word rogation comes from the Latin verb *rogare*, meaning "to ask", which reflects the beseeching of God for protection from calamities.

Rogation Days are the three days preceding Ascension Day. These days are devoted to asking for God's blessing on agriculture and industry. Rogation invites people to ask for blessing – for a particular place; for all its inhabitants; for every endeavour to promote the common good.
